DEADLINE

Submit your application pages, including transcript, letter of recommendation, etc. in the order listed and mail the entire application by the **February 15th deadline.**

Checklist

- **Cover sheet** – A blank sheet of paper with your name and a recent photo
- **Application pages 1 - 4**
- **Unofficial transcript from your current school (if you are a college student, must be from your college)**
- **One letter of recommendation**
- ***Optional* - One creative "8 ½ x 11" sheet of memorabilia (scrapbook style or collage, color or B&W)**
